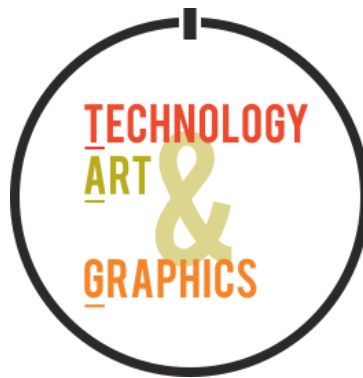
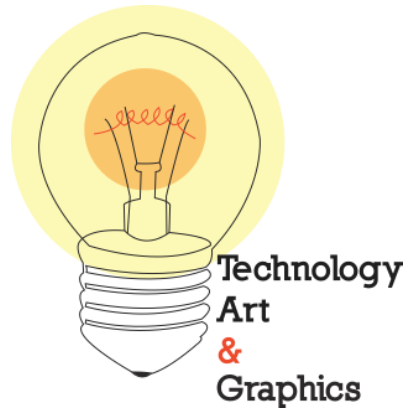

The TAG Program

About the Center for Visual Art: The Center for Visual Art (CVA) is the off-campus gallery of Metropolitan State College's nationally accredited Art Department. In addition to showing significant contemporary art by artists of diverse backgrounds, the award-winning CVA serves as an interactive art laboratory for Metro State students and the larger community, playing an integral role in the college's teaching mission.

About the Education Outreach Program: For over 17 years, CVA has strived to provide inner-city youth with excellent art instruction that increases appreciation and knowledge of the arts through its education outreach programming. Starting in summer 2010 the CVA will be offering teens, ages 13-18, with an opportunity to gain hands-on experience with state-of-the-art creative software through its Technology Art and Graphics (TAG) education outreach program.

The program will encourage positive, constructive use of free time while providing art focused instruction in graphic design, visual communication, and computer literacy. Workshops will increase participants' job readiness skills, awareness of the relationship between art and technology, ability to creatively express their thoughts and feeling about critical issues, and provide opportunity for positive social interaction in a safe environment.

Summer Program Information: TAG summer program will (tentatively) take place July 12-23, 2010 on Metropolitan State College of Denver's campus. The program will have a morning & afternoon session and will focus on teaching youth how to use state-of-the-art creative software to express their thoughts and feelings about critical issues happening to them or in their community. Workshops vary in length, and usually last for 90 - 90 minutes.
